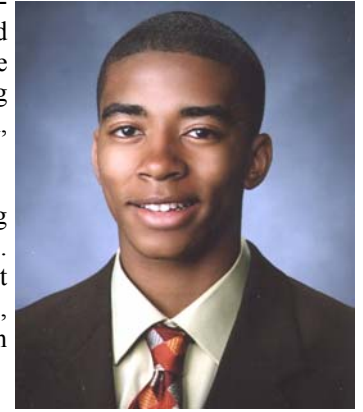
Candice's proudest moments in high school was being crowned the 2007 Prom Queen.
